



**Calling for the selection of a theater group project to participate in the 20th edition  
of the Granada International University Theater Meeting (EITUG)**

**1. PURPOSE OF THE CALL**

- 1.1. The University of Granada is proud to announce its 20 th International Meeting for University Theatre Companies, where new stage productions of its own and by distinguished national and international institutions will be presented. This project is the outcome of our continuous efforts and commitment to fostering university theatre activities and to creating a space which, on many occasions, has been the origin of theatrical enterprises with remarkable impact at both local and national levels.
- 1.2. On the 20-31 of March, 2023, under the name of “International Meeting for University Theatre Companies” (Encuentro Internacional de Teatro Universitario de Granada, EITUG) we will be celebrating all performing arts, the dialog among cultures, and a lively exchange through the universal language born on stage.

**2. MODALITIES OF PARTICIPATION**

**2.1. MODALITY On site**

- 2.1.1. Guests who agree to participate in the face-to-face mode will have to pay for their transfer to Granada.
- 2.1.2. The organization will pay the following costs:
  - Necesidades Technical support (lighting and sound equipment)
  - Full board and lodging (up to 3 nights maximum) for the cast (up to 8), plus a maximum of 4 other people (including 2 or 3 supporting staff and director)
  - Exceptionally, for non-European companies coming from distant countries, a longer stay (5 to 7 days maximum) could be considered.

**2.2. MODALITY On line**

- 2.2.1. This modality of participation will be developed through the YouTube channel of the Madraza Center for Contemporary Culture, of the Vice-rectorate for University Extension and Cultural Heritage of the Granada University.
- 2.2.2. The groups that opt for this participation option must also fill in the application form specified in section 3.1. of these foundations.



### **3. REQUESTS**

- 3.1. Applications will be made online through the digital form hosted at the following web address: [sl.ugr.es/0cQn](https://sl.ugr.es/0cQn)  
All the information requested in the form must be attached.
- 3.2. The period for submitting applications will be open from the publication of this call on the website of the Vice-Rectorate for University Extension and Cultural Heritage until 2:00 p.m. on December 22, 2022 (Spanish time).
- 3.3. All languages are welcome, but translation of the shows will not be provided. Groups that wish to do so must include subtitles for their performances in their proposals and exhibitions.
- 3.4. The duration of shows should not exceed 90 minutes.

### **4. SELECTION OF PROPOSALS**

- 4.1. The University of Granada will designate a commission of specialists that will be in charge of evaluating and selecting the projects that will be included in the 20th edition of the International Meeting of University Theater of Granada (EITUG).  
To do this, and within the term stipulated by the organization, they will have to send a file in a format compatible with YouTube with the complete representation of the work.
- 4.2. The result of the selection will be announced throughout the month of January 2023.
- 4.3. Selected companies will be required to forward a letter of support by the regents of the university, signed by the chancellor or vice-chancellor.
- 4.4. The groups selected for the online modality will have to authorize in writing, according to the printed model that the organization will provide, the reproduction of the work by the YouTube channel of the Madraza Center for Contemporary Culture of the Vice-rectorate for University Extension and Cultural Heritage of the Granada University.

### **5. ACCEPTANCE OF THE CLAUSES**
